OVERLAP PROCEDURE

- The overlap form must accompany any minor form in order to be accepted
- Student must fill out and sign an overlap form when filing for a minor or a double major
- A copy of the overlap form and the minor form are input in the student's BME academic database and then filed in the student's file
- The original form and the minor for are then sent to the HSEAS UG Coordinator for further processing
