Computational Fluid Dynamics (CFD) Presentation

Junior Lauren Blanch gave a presentation on chemical engineering Professor David Foster's research group. Blanch discussed her current research within the group where she uses CFD to model patient-specific carotid arteries. Her research aims to study the flow patterns linked to carotid webs and thrombi which disrupt the normal blood flow throughout the body. Blanch further stated that these disruptions can lead to increased risks for stroke.
