## Initiative 2019: SPIE Laser Show






Student Chapter provided all logistics for laser show provided by SPIE.

## Initiative 2019: Light & Lilacs




- 500k general attendees at Rochester Lilac Festival

- 33 people in attendance
- Included panel, roundtable discussion, guided meditation and board game social event



Attending students reported that it was meaningful to have this discussion and to **know** that they are not alone in experiencing the stress of grad school, or dealing with things like impostor syndrome, managing expectations, and setting boundaries. 
